**AGREEMENT
with British Marine (BM) regarding
Pre-Employment Medical Examinations (PEMEs)**

Whereas both BM and the undersigned Medical Clinic both agree to co-operate together with owners and manning agents to ensure that seamen are examined before embarking on seagoing voyages to ensure they fully conform to the medical standards of the relevant National and Flag Authorities and to the recommended standards attached hereto (British Marine's Standard PEME).

And Whereas BML has appointed Marine Response Ltd (MRL) to oversee the running of the scheme, to collect statistics and to advise upon any amendments to the scheme as may from time to time be required

It is hereby agreed that:

- at the request of BM and / or its Member, the Clinic will perform, the medical tests as outlined in the BM Standard PEME as described in the attachment;

- MRL representatives will meet annually with the Clinic to review the procedures and quality standards of the clinics performing PEMEs for BM's crews;
- BM will issue a list of approved Clinics for circulation to its Members and will promote the listed Clinics as quality service providers to Members for performing PEMEs;
- BM reserves the right to add any Clinic to the approved list that meets the standards of the scheme;
- BM also reserves the right to delete the Clinic from its approved list. Conversely, the Clinic has the right to request being removed from BM's approval list upon notification from the Clinic; and
- MRL will receive from the Clinic, on a bi-annual basis (every 6 months), statistics on the number of Club Member seafarers who both pass and fail the minimum medical exam as outlined in the Attachment. For those who fail, the Clinic will also provide statistics as to which tests were failed.
- The basic details (name, d.o.b., seaman's card No.) of any seaman who is adjudged **Permanently Unfit** will be circulated immediately by the examining clinic to the other members of the scheme who will decline to examine that seaman under the BML scheme.
